



We will be hosted once again by the Natick Fire Department, 22 East Central St. (Rt.135) courtesy of MIFDI member Captain Eugene Rothman, Natick Fire Training Officer. The training will be provided by Boston Fire Department Captain Ryan McGovern. Captain McGovern will share a presentation of his personal experience during a MAYDAY incident. This program has been presented to many groups including the FDIC for the purpose of educating others who may face a MAYDAY in the course of their career.

SCHEDULE: 0915 Coffee, 1000 Presentation, 1130 Business Meeting, 1200 Lunch (off site).

**DIRECTIONS:** From Rt. 128/I 95 take Rt.9 WEST in Wellesley to Rt.27 SOUTH in Natick. Continue SOUTH on Rt.27 for 3-traffic lights, that will be Rt.135. Turn left on Rt.135 to the second left, that is Clarendon St which brings you to the parking lot in the rear of the Public Safety Bldg.

From the Mass Pike (I 90), Take EXIT 13 to Rt. 30 EAST. Follow Rt.30 to Rt. 27 (3-lights). Turn right on Rt.27 SOUTH to Rt. 135. Turn left on Rt.135 EAST to the second left which is Clarendon St. which brings you to the parking lot in the rear of the Public Safety Bldg.

The September meeting of MIFDI was held on September 27, 2017 hosted the by the Wayland Fire Department courtesy of Chief David Houghton.

Our training was presented by Sudbury Fire Captain Timothy Choate. Tim is also an Instructor at the Massachusetts Firefighting Academy and began with an explanation and walk-through of the new on-line application process for MFA courses. Tim then provided an abbreviated version of the presentation on ASHE (Active Shooter/Hostile Event). This program is a must see for every public safety agency as our world continues to grow more violent. We must have a strategic plan in place to prepare for these incidents in our community.

The unofficial meeting reconvened for lunch at a nearby Bertucci's Restaurant.





## "MAYDAY MAYDAY"

# 5 Reasons to Call a Firefighter Emergency/MAYDAY

- 1. Separated from Crew or "Lost"
- 2. SCBA Malfunction or Low Air
- 3. Injured or Disabled
- 4. Trapped, Pinned, or Entangled in Debris
- 5. Any life threatening condition that cannot be resolved in 30 seconds
