NOVEMBER MEETING:

The November meeting will be held on <u>THURSDAY</u>, <u>NOVEMBER 29</u>, <u>2012</u> (<u>NOTE CHANGE OF DAY</u>). We needed to change the day to make this work before the end of the year for those members needing EMS credits. This meeting will provide 2 continuing education hours approved by OEMS.

Our meeting will be hosted by Boston Medflight located at Hanscom Air Force Base in Bedford courtesy of MedFlight Training Coordinator Mary Arredondo. This will be MIFDIøs first visit to MedFlight. The presentation will include safety procedures when operating around the aircraft at incident scenes as well as what is expected from us to help the pilots when landing and taking off. This will also be a good opportunity for us to ensure that our LZøs (Landing zones) are updated for our own communities.

Following the presentation, we will be given a tour of the MedFlight facility which includes the helicopter, a medical fixed-wing aircraft, two ground transport ambulances, and an on-site sim-lab.

NOTE: Due to this being in a secure military installation we have to follow a minor background check in order to enter the site. For those members that signed the list at the October meeting, you should be all set. For those who did not and would like to attend, you must contact President Roche by Tuesday, November 27 either by email captroche@aol.com or telephone @ 508-655-2528 to be placed on the list. Be sure to give your name AND date of birth.

If for some reason your plans change and you would like to attend but did not call ahead, do not be discouraged from attending. You will be held at the Visitors Center until you are cleared to pass. As with any secure facility you should have you drivers license with you at all times. Members on duty in uniform and in marked vehicles should not have any issues, but again do not be discouraged from attending, MedFlight often hosts visitors attending EMS training classes as well as tour groups.



From 128

- Exit the highway at Exit 30B (Rt. 2A West).
- ◆ Follow Rt. 2A West for about 2 miles until you see the sign for Hanscom Field.
- ♦ Turn right onto Hanscom Drive, and follow signs for Hanscom AFB keeping to the right side of the road
- As you approach the entrance to Hanscom AFB, there will be a visitor's center on the right, opposite the guard shack. It is necessary for you to check in at the visitor center and get a visitor's pass. You will be asked to state the nature of your business on base. Please be sure to have a picture ID with you when you check in.
- Massachusetts residents need to have auto registration and license.
- Out-of-state residents need to have insurance documents as well as registration and license.
- Out-of-country visitors/residents will need to bring their passport/visa with them.
- Visitors with rental cars will need documents from the rental agency along with their license.

After checking in at the Visitor's Center

- Turn right out of the Visitor's Center parking lot on to Vandenberg Street (you will need
 to stop briefly at the guard shack directly across from the visitor center the guard will
 then let you continue on Vandenberg Street).
- Proceed approximately ¼ mile to a stop sign and turn left onto Marrett Street (you will see a suspended airplane display at this intersection).
- At the next set of lights (you will see another suspended airplane display), go straight onto Forbes Street.
- At the second stop sign, take a left our office is on your right. There is a MedFlight sign in the window. You may park in the large visitor's on the left, just past the BMF hangar. INSTRUCTORS CORNER:

Key Points When Using an Extension Ladder

RAISING:

Always make sure that overhead is clear of power lines and obstructions before raising the ladder.

When raising/lowering a ladder, use hand over hand on the halyard and avoid allowing the rope to slide through your hands.

Prior to raising/lowering the ladder, make sure that hands and feet are clear from the rungs or through the side of the beams.

Be sure that pawls are locked prior to climbing the ladder.

POSITIONING:

RESCUE: Place the top of the ladder even or slightly below the windowsill.

ENTERING WINDOW: Position the ladder alongside the window and three rungs above the windowsill. If window is wide enough, place the ladder into the window.

ROOF ACCESS: Ladder should be extended at least three rungs above the roof.

VENTILATION: Position ladder on the windward side of the opening slightly above the top of the window.

OPERATING A LINE: Position the ladder so the head of the ladder rests on the wall above the opening.

ANGLE: The desired climbing of 75-degrees is achieved when placing the base of the ladder roughly ½ of the distance of the height.

VERIBLES: There are conditions encountered when a beam raise will be required due to narrow alleyways and driveways, parked vehicles, dumpsters, etc. Be sure members are trained in both forward and side ladder raising techniques.
