





# CDC EBOLA GUIDANCE **EVALUATING INTERNATIONAL TRAVELERS FOR LEVEL OF RISK** HIGH Direct contact with infected body fluids or with the body of a person who died of Ebola while not wearing personal **RISK** protective equipment (PPE). Close contact (within 3 feet) with a person showing symptoms of Ebola while not **RISK** wearing PPE. Direct contact with a person showing symptoms of Ebola while wearing PPE. Having been in a country with widespread Ebola less than 21 days ago with no known **RISK** exposure. Brief contact, such as shaking hands, with a person who has Ebola, while not wearing PPE. Being in the same room for a short amount of time with a person who has Ebola Direct contact with a person showing symptoms of Ebola while wearing PPE. Travel on an airplane with a person showing symptoms of Ebola. NO Contact with a person with Ebola before symptoms began. RISK Having been in a country with widespread Ebola transmission more than 21 days ago. In a country without widespread Ebola and no exposure.

# **LAST ALARM:**



# New Regional Fire Training Facility

The New Bedford Fire Department along with fire departments from Fairhaven and Mattapoisett, will soon open a new Regional Training Facility located on the grounds of a former city transfer station at 1103 Shawmut Ave.

The facility was funded through a 2013 Assistance to Firefighters Grant provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The new facility will allow firefighters in the area to train and practice fire and rescue tactics under live-fire conditions.

Incorporated into the new facility are two "burn rooms", an interchangeable maze to allow firefighters to practice navigating dark, confined spaces, forcible entry props, and a roof-vent prop which will allow firefighters to practice cutting ventilation holes in a roof.
