

#### **RECALL OF MEETING #2023-5**

The May meeting of MIFDI was held on Wednesday May 24, 2023 hosted by the Waltham Fire Department courtesy of Chief Andrew Mullin and Captain John Bonadio.

# End of COVID-19 Public Health Emergency


According to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), May 11, 2023 marked the end of the federal COVID-19 PHE declaration. What you need to know:

Access to COVID-19 vaccines will generally not be affected for now. The government is currently distributing free COVID -19 vaccines for all adults and children.

COVID-19 home tests may not be covered by insurance providers and will no longer be required to waive the costs of free COVID-19 test kits.

Treatments will remain available. Medication to prevent severe COVID-19 will remain available for free while supplies last. After that, the price will be determined by the medication manufacturer and your health insurance provider.

National reporting of COVID-19 may change. Current data will allow CDC to monitor the virus in America in real time. All hospitals are required to report COVID-19 data through the end of April 2024.

**Firefighter Robert W. Halloran** ACTIVE member of the Worcester Fire Department died on May 11, 2023 at age 62 due to occupational cancer.






