



EMS RUN

Masking up ... Again

Due to a recent spike in Covid 19, RSV and the flu virus, many hospitals and health care facilities are reverting back to requiring face masks for all patient care givers during direct interactions with patients.

Patients and visitors will be strongly encouraged, but not required in some facilities, to wear a mask when interacting with staff. For those already wearing a mask, some hospitals will want you to wear a mask provided from their facility over your own mask to ensure that the mask is clean and effective.

Those of us in the field of EMS should continue to wear a N95 mask when responding to any EMS call if your patient is presenting with a cough or flu-like symptoms. These patients should also be given a N95 mask to wear while interacting during patient care as well as during transport.

A REMINDER TO ALWAYS ASK YOUR PATIENT THESE THREE IMPORTANT QUESTIONS;

Do you have a fever or flu-like symptoms?

Do you have a Covid-19 infection and are you in an isolation period?

Have you been exposed to a know Covid exposure within the past 10 days?

As with all vital patient information, this information must be shared with the receiving medical facility to insure proper isolation.

It is good practice to always keep a mask in your pocket and extra clean masks in your first-in bag

INSTRUCTORS CORNER

Cancer Awareness & Prevention



Use SCBA from initial attack until overhaul is completed and atmosphere is monitored. (Not wearing SCBA in both active and post-fire environments is the most dangerous voluntary activity in the fire service today).

Do gross field decon of PPE to remove as much soot and particles as possible.

Use wet-nap or baby wipes to remove as much soot as possible from head, neck, jaw, throat, underarms, and hands immediately.

Change your clothes and wash them immediately after a fire.

Shower thoroughly after a fire.

Clean your PPE, gloves, hood, and helmet immediately after a fire.

Do not take contaminated clothes or PPE home or store in your vehicle.

Decon the interior of fire apparatus after fires.

Keep bunker gear out of living areas and sleeping quarters.

Stop the use of all tobacco products.

The importance of annual medical examinations cannot be overstated. Early detection and early treatment are essential to increasing survival.

FIREFIGHTERS ARE EXPOSED THROUGH THE FOLLOWING; Ingestion, Inhalation, Absorption (Groin-300%, Jaw-93%, Head 43%)

For every 5-degree increase in skin temperature, body absorption increases 400%
