



<u>REPORT of the PRESIDENT:</u>

Our March meeting was hosted by the Massachusetts Department of Fire Services at the Stow Campus of the Mass Fire Academy. I thank MFA Director Eric Littmann for welcoming MIFDI and thanks also to Scott Cluett for his informative presentation on ASHER.

This past March, the fire service in Massachusetts lost a great friend and supporter of firefighters and their families, Mr. Norman Knight. Norman died on March 9, 2024 at age 99. He was founder of the 100 Club of Massachusetts, a charity organization that offers assistance to the families of firefighters and police officers killed in the line of duty. He was also a director of the Massachusetts Fallen Firefighter Memorial Committee which created the Fallen Firefighter Memorial at the State House in Boston. His charitable foundation is also credited with establishment of a Hyperbaric Medicine Center at the Massachusetts Eye & Ear Infirmary to help victims recover from severe smoke and carbon monoxide poisoning. Firefighters throughout the Commonwealth owe this humble and generous man our gratitude for his contributions to the fire service. Thank you Norman, May you now Rest in Peace.

INSTRUCTORS CORNER *Thousands of cars in Mass recalled due to fire risk*

According to the auto company Carfax, the number of "Park Outside" recall warnings from Federal Regulators and auto makers has increased by 40 percent nationally and 45 percent in Greater Boston during the past year.

The warnings recommend NOT parking the recalled vehicle inside a garage or within 50-feet of a structure. More than 72,000 vehicles in Massachusetts are under a "park outside" recall. That is a staggering number of vehicles at risk!

Carfax said owners should not ignore recall notices and to pay close attention to the vehicle maintenance requirements. People unsure if their vehicle has a recall should check the **National Highway Traffic Safety Administration** website.
