RECALL OF MEETING #2024-05

The May meeting of MIFDI was held on Wednesday May 22, 2024 hosted by the Norwood Fire Department in their Public Safety Training Room courtesy of Chief Tim Bailey.

The training was provided by KONE Elevator with a presentation on Elevator Operations and Safety. KONE Elevator Tech Greg Wilkinson offered a power-point program which included; Elevator history, various types of elevators that we encounter, Lock-out/Tag -Out, 3502 key Phase 1 & 2, and safe procedures when removing occupants.

The important "take home" points included;

- Be sure to power down the elevator before attempting a removal
- Have your Dispatch notify the elevator company ASAP, if you can hold off on removal of occupants it is safer to wait for an elevator tech to arrive
- Avoid entering the hoistway unless absolutely necessary
- Your 3502 key will also open the top hatch door of the elevator car
- When shutting down power, be sure that there is no water on the floor, always stand off to the side and look away when operating the power switch

Always use caution, **ELEVATORS CAN EASILY INJURE OR KILL YOU!**



<u>EMS RUN</u> Pediatric Vehicular Heatstroke (PVH)

As we approach the summer season, it is important to be aware that more that 965 children have died of heatstroke in the past 25 years due to being left inside a hot car. The main reasons for these preventable tragedies are; FORGOTTEN BY A CAREGIVER, GAINED ACCESS ON THEIR OWN, or KNOWINGLY LEFT BY A CAREGIVER.

SOME IMPORTANT FACTS:

- A child's body temperature rises three to five times faster than an adults.
- Heatstroke begins when the core body temperature reaches approximately 104 degrees.
- A child can die when their body temperature reaches 107 degrees.
- In 2023, 29 children died of heatstroke in vehicles.

When responding to a call from a concerned citizen about a child alone inside a car on a hot summer day, don't waste time looking for the parent or waiting for a tow company to unlock the door, use a window punch on a window furthest away from the child seat and get the child out quickly to an air conditioned ambulance for evaluation. Insurance will cover the cost of the window, a small price to pay for the safety of a child.

INSTRUCTORS CORNER

The Atlantic Hurricane Season runs from June 1 through November 30

According to predictions, the 2024 Hurricane Season could possibly be unusually active due to warmer ocean temperatures and favorable atmospheric conditions with:

- 23 Tropical Storms (Winds 39 mph or higher)
- 11 could become hurricanes (Winds 74 mph or higher)
- 5 could be major, Category 3,4,5 (Winds 111 mph or higher)
